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ARTS & CRAFT VENDOR AGREEMENT

August 10th -13th, 2023

This Arts & Crafts Agreement is between the Shoshone-Bannock Festival Committee and **Vendor**

Arts & Craft Vendor Space Fee must be paid in full to the Festival Vendor Committee by **July 24, 2023**. **No Exceptions**. There will be no solicitations for sale of merchandise of any type without full payment or Festival Vendor committee consent and/or knowledge.

1. Vendors are responsible to provide documentation of Tribal Enrollment or Census number prior to acceptance of application by the Festival Vendor Committee.
2. There are approximately 49 (10x10) covered booths available for Arts & Crafts; **Directly behind these booths (10x10 area only) is either for one (1) medium size vehicle or camping, not both.** These booths will be provided with lighting and two outlets. Air conditioning systems and personal generators are not allowed.
3. Approximately 20 open standard spaces (10x20) are available for Arts & Crafts; **Camping behind these booths will be limited to (10x20)**, which is also on a “First Paid, First Space Assigned Basis.” These booths will NOT be provided with any lighting, but two power outlets may be provided depending on availability.
4. **No payment arrangements will be made; BOOTHS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE A NUMBER IS ASSIGNED.**
5. There is NO RV hookups, no power for polishing machine, small appliances, etc....available at the festival grounds.
6. **Limited Power is available and you must furnish your own 110 amp extension cords.** United Laboratory (UL) rating must be on all electric cords and surge protectors (if used), to avoid any electrical fires. Booths will use electricity wisely and not over load circuits. Generators are recommended in case of power failure.
7. Daily inspections will take place during the festival by the Fort Hall Fire District & Festival Committee, if a vendor is in non-compliance:
First offense: Verbal Warning given
Second offense: Written Warning given fined the amount of \$100.00
Third offense: Escorted off the Festival Grounds and prosecuted in tribal courts.
8. Vendor cannot allow another vendor (part/individual) to set up in their booths unless (party/individual) is listed on application and has signed this agreement.
9. REFUND, there will be absolutely no refunds due to natural catastrophes or weather conditions that should arise throughout the festival.
10. **Depending upon Availability**; if an application is received after July 24th, 2023, there will be a late charge of \$50.00.

11. **Vendors must maintain a clean environment in and around booth area!** Vendors are responsible of disposing of their own garbage.
12. Vendors will be issued only 1 vehicle pass upon arrival, if booth is in a restricted parking area. **ABSOLUTELY NO driving in/out of the arbor/vendor area after 5:00 PM – 11:00 pm on Thursday & Friday evenings, and 12 noon – 11:00 pm Saturday - Sunday. If you are needing to leave, you may park out in the designated parking area.**
13. Beaded items for sale must be *Authentic Native American Indian* made, **NO IMITATIONS.**
14. No selling of Food (consumable items or drinks) at Arts & Craft vendor booths or camp ground area.
15. No selling on festival grounds of pirated or unauthorized filming of powwows, on DVD's & CD's!
16. **No walking vendors are allowed on the Festival Grounds.**
17. Consumption of any alcoholic beverages or use of illegal drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED! It is the Vendors responsibility to enforce this policy among his/her employees and associates. Vendors are who are intoxicated or in possession of alcohol/drugs shall be turned over to local law enforcement and removed from the grounds.

Vendors violating any of the conditions shall be immediately subject to cancellation of the agreement and will be escorted from the premises by local law enforcement, merchandise items will be confiscated and possibly prosecuted in tribal courts.

I understand that this application does not guarantee any liability from the Shoshone-Bannock Festival Committee or The Shoshone-Bannock Tribes for natural catastrophes or weather conditions that should arise or for accidents, fires, theft or any circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Festival Committee or The Shoshone-Bannock Tribes.

I have read and fully understand the terms of this Arts & Craft Vendor Agreement and agree to comply with all the provisions stated.
